- Supervises the maintenance of the established protocols for infection prevention e.g.
 isolation procedures, hand washing techniques used, the use of hand rub, change of IV set,
 change of central line dressing, availability of supplies, terminal cleaning of a unit and
 disinfection of equipment etc. in the hospital.
- Corrects and teaches staff whenever the need arises during rounds. E.g. proper use of gloves, improper handling of equipment, practice of aseptic precautions etc.
- Participates in the formal teaching programmes during the orientation of new staff.
- The staff should be informed about the steps to be taken in case of an accidental needle stick injury and the availability of hepatitis vaccination.
- Tracks down the source of an organism such as in the case of an outbreak of salmonella or MRSA infections. This includes environmental and personnel monitoring when appropriate.
- Carries out surveillance through regular contact with all hospital departments, particularly those providing patient care.
